This is related to freedom of speech thought, expression and assembly and that conduct activities must comply with Federal, state and local laws as well as campus regulations. This policy defines: Expressive conduct and that is refers to behavior designed to convey a message, including speechmaking, communicating, petitioning picketing, leafleting, demonstrating and rallies. We define time and place and matter referring to a set of boundaries in which expressive conduct is permitted. Demonstrations or rallies refers to an action by a mass group or collection of groups of people in favor of a cause or people partaking in a protest against a cause of concern.
