	planning. Student Planning has been live and in use at Clackamas since fall term 2017 and this has been	
	the sole system taught to new incoming students.	
	 On 3/29/21 students will only be able to register using student planning through Self Service. 	
	 Web advisor will not be supported by Ellucian after this date. 	
	 Students can use both systems through Spring and then Web Advisor will go away. 	
	Advisors are hosting a drop in session for new, returning and current students to help	
	with self-service or any other advising needs.	
	■ Drop in Sessions will be Monday from 11-1 and Thursday 3-5.	
	We have had Live Chat up and running for over a year and we are wanting to find the right
