Retention and Completion ARC Sub- Committee Annual Report Ryan Stewart: 30- minutes	 Ryan gave an overview of the sub-committee's membership, goals, and projects. The group has focused on reviewing retention data and has focused on looking at data related to the move to the online environment. The group noticed a trend that communication was an issue for our students. Including "I don't know who to contact", "I am not getting a response", or "I want to give a kudos to someone". These communications that are coming to people's in-boxes are highlighting that students don't know how to give feedback to us. Barriers identified: Waiting for the EYES survey is too late to help resolve issues for students Group discussed requiring students to provide their names as part of providing feedback. The group identified the need to have a central location for gathering feedback and has developed a web page where students can submit their feedback to the group <u>https://sitefinitytest1.clackamas.edu/test-pages/feedback</u> Faculty Senate had questions for the committee about how they would be managing/responding to feedback that is received. Lauren provided information from institutional research related to demographic break down of 2017 through 2019 student completion data. Looking at first time ever in college and current students Comparison of what we see at CCC verses Clackamas County. Jennifer asked: What would be some items that we should be thinking about? How this data relates to Access, Retention and Completion? We are really losing a lot of student in the first term. For various reasons they are not completing any credits. It might be good to share this information with the subcommittee leads.
