Proposal Renaming ARC Steerinng & Policy committee to SEM & Strategic Planning Committee: In order to align with the newly adopted SEM plan and CCC Strategic Plan which are central to the vision and mission of the ARC committee, it is proposed that we rename the existing ARC Steering and Policy subcommittee to the ARC SEM and Strategic Planning Committee. As the current chair of this sub-committee, Jennifer Anderson reviewed the original goals of this sub-committee with the group and discussed where that work will live moving forward including:

Policy Work

The original goal of the Policy portion of this committee was to provide a group of readers who would review and provide feedback to the policy originators, ask clarifying questions, and provide an editing eye on the materials prior to a full ARC committee review. Policy development and editing work happens at an intermittent pace so there are often many months when this group does not have any policies to review. Going forward, this process will switch to having the ARC Chair ask for volunteers from the current ARC members to review and provide feedback for policies prior to bringing the material to the full committee for review.

Shared Governance

A question was posed about where conversations regarding the potential changes to the ARC committee structure will go as our Shared Governance practices shift to new Councils. At this point, we don't know how these changes will impact ARC, but we'll know more once the charters for those groups have been developed. The Chair will bring potential changes regarding changes to the ARC committee related to the changes with Shared Governance to the full ARC committee for future discussion.

However, a student petition is only required after a class has already started while a granted petition always applies to a course. 	
Review Draft Policy Documents (Information Sharing) Jennifer Anderson & Individual Review	 OSBA has recommended that the college have a BOE level policy regarding Student Conduct. The attached draft was reviewed at College Council recently. ARC is invited to review and comment. We are in the process of transitioning the existing ARC 601 Expressive Speech policy into a new BOE level policy and administrative regulation for Expressive Conduct. This policy has gone through a number of iterations and we have a new full draft of both the policy and the administrative regulation to review. This policy identifies the time, place, and manner for expressive conduct. This policy, as a more all-encompassing policy, needs to land at a higher level than just ARC. We will be working together to create a version that will move up to the Board of Education's policy review process.
