		<ul> <li>Catering requests are available for food trucks. The committee would like more information to be able to utilize this option in the future.</li> <li>There are some concerns with winter term and inclement weather</li> <li>Sales tickets for food trucks are averaging:         <ul> <li>40-60 tickets for OC Campus</li> <li>20 tickets for Harmony Campus</li> <li>4-5 tickets for Wilsonville Campus</li> </ul> </li> <li>Q: Wilsonville's food trucks are not being utilized can we extend communication to students with email or other methods?         <ul> <li>A: There has been communication to students/staff. Also, food trucks hours are from 4pm to 7pm to meet the needs of students.</li> <li>Q: Do we have student feedback on food trucks yet?</li> <li>A: There was some initial confusion on communication, however, feedback has been good. There are concerns from students about variety and cost.</li> </ul></li></ul>	
Fresh Food Vending	Wesley Buchholz	<ul> <li>CCC has also partnered with Canteen, who is the fresh food vendor that stocks the new vending machines on campus. The locations of the fresh food vending machines are: <ul> <li>Training Center</li> <li>ITC</li> <li>Community Center</li> <li>Barlow Hall</li> </ul> </li> <li>CCC can request an assortment of foods to be stocked in the vending machines including gluten free, vegetarian and vegan.</li> <li>If interested there is the opportunity to tour the facility that's making the fresh food – it is local</li> <li>The vending machines are remotely monitored by Canteen</li> <li>Wilsonville vending machines have been utilized but not to a large extent</li> </ul>	Discussion Decision Advocacy <u>Information</u> Document
