Home Orchards Society	Tonia Lordy		<p>The Home Orchard Society is a nonprofit educational organization that has been at Clackamas Community College's Oregon City campus since 1986. For more about the Home Orchards society visit their website at http://www.homeorchardsociety.org/</p> <p>This year The Home Orchard Society initially planned on adding a high tunnel, however, the expense was cost prohibitive. They amended their proposed project to add a 200 square foot cold frame hoop house approximately the size of 10' x 20' instead. <p>Wheelchair Charging Station</p>	<p>Ray Atkinson</p>		<p>ASG approved funding to install a wheelchair charging station supplied by Clearview Disability Resource Center.</p> <p>Transportation is seeking approval from CUDC for an appropriate outside location to install the wheelchair charging station on the OC campus. Transportation has proposed either outside of Gregory Forum or outside of Roger Rook for placement of the unit.</p> <p>CUDC has the following comments/ concerns/questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A wheelchair recharge can take up to 30 minutes • Inclement weather could be prohibitive to outside charging • It was determined that the proposed Gregory Forum location may not be the best location as it is not as visible from the transit center • The north entrance to Roger Rook may be a troublesome location due to the potential exposure to the weather. It was proposed to use the NW entrance outside of the testing center • The associated signage would need to match our current signage program • The charging station plugs into an existing outlet and as such may be an easy target for vandals • It was proposed that the charging unit location be placed on the inside of a building. Ray expressed concern regarding installing the unit on the interior of either building as the buildings are being locked afterhours. He indicated that the reason for an outside location is that it would be accessible all hours for charging. • Roger Rook's vestibule is a plausible location that will be investigated further 	<p>Discussion Decision Advocacy Information Document</p>
