Plan A – space lease for a building 1 mile away from CCC Plan B – two trailers at Clairmont Hall parking lot south west corner • 8x10 • 14x66 – 3 rooms (center large area is reception, waiting, lab, exam room) Restroom needs – the trailers do not have any restrooms and would need access to Clairmont for restrooms Currently open three days a week during the daytime hours (9-5pm) Low volume of patients of expected 3-4 per hours.
