Wrap-up for the Ireland Trip:

- Surveys need to get collected (no one has responded)

 - Using the workshop to collect the deposit (dual-enroll); explore as an option
 - Community members were being billed when they signed up for the workshop

France Trip Updates:

- Meeting went great overall (3 participants attended)
 - Deposit will be due next Friday, 02/03
- France program contact got back with updated materials
- Extensive outreach needs to happen
 - Ernesto will plan to reach out French instructors at PSU to outreach for more participants
 - Perhaps high school outreach (Ernesto will reach out to ACC H.S. partners)
 - o Need at least 10 participants to be able to run the program
 - Only three individuals have filled out the interest sheet
- Accommodations have been set in place for Barcelona and airlines are still in the works
- Meeting with Jeff still needs to happen to discuss the money/deposits handling
- No students have expressed interest in COMM-140 class
- Dates for the trip have been settled: Jun. 17th -July 4th (Dates are still going to dependent on airfare).
- No workshop yet- Ernesto and Kerrie working on developing the verbiage for those courses
 - Classes might be eliminated all together or Ernesto could offer a FR-199 for some credit (TBD)

CIBER Grant

- Feedback and learning:

 - They handle all aspects of trips (insurance, logistics, programming)
