

PROJECT DEFINITIONS

The **Guided Pathways Task Force** has several workgroups to complete guided pathways-related projects. Each workgroup is comprised of a cross-functional team of staff, faculty, and administrators. The workgroups for the 2018-2019 academic year are:



NAVIGATE

Guides the implementation of EAB's Navigate, a software platform for **student onboarding**, advising and academic planning.



CURRICULUM

Establishes **educational focus areas** for degree and certificate seeking students, as well as developing guided pathways **curriculum maps**.



PRE-COLLEGE

Ensures that pre-college programs are **on-ramps** to guided pathways and that pre-college students are supported through **transitions** to reduce time to completion goals.



COLLABORATIVE ADVISING

Ensures that students receive accurate and consistent information during advising by aligning the work of academic and career coaches and faculty advisors.



COMMUNICATION

Creates comprehensive strategic **communications** for implementing guided pathways at CCC and develops content for internal and external audiences.
