Portal/Student Email Update	Joe Austin presented information from task force regarding Student Email and Portal update (handout: Microsoft Live@edu Student Email and Datatel Active Campus Portal). College Email through Microsoft is being looked at for students. At no cost to the college, Microsoft would provide students with: • Hosted mail • 5 GB free storage space and 10 MB attachments • Calendars and Online workspaces • Mobile alerts and document sharing • Instant messaging and blogs Now looking for students to pilot test the email process. All advertising would be suppressed, can be customized by students but would retain identifier for internal use. Student accounts are retained for 1 year after graduation and then rolled into alumni status. System available to students 24/7, 365 days/year. Anticipated start date: Spring term '08. Information shared regarding Datatel Active Campus Portal, providing a gateway to all resources that a user might need. Users would have fingertip access to critical data. Users spend more time collaborating and making better use of their time and resources, not having to jump between multiple systems, databases, and screens. Anticipated start date: Fall term '08. Joe also mentioned that there will be a Vulnerability Study in March. This will be a weeklong event to "attack" our systems and see where problems occur. Will keep apprised of any problems that present themselves.
