Governor's Budget Update	Courtney Wilton shared a powerpoint (attachment #1) outlining the financial forecast update for December 2, 2008: CCC Projected Revenue Under the Governor's Budget Community College funding is flat S2.9M decline next biennium for CCC (due to equalization and the 06-07 drop in FTE) Total revenue over the next two years is flat; combined state support and property taxes Scheduled tuition increase of \$3 per year will offset declines in state formula revenue. CCC Projected Expenditures Next Two Years Expenditures expected to increase around 5.5% a year; \$8.7m over next two years. \$8.4m (96%) relates to personal services CCC Projected gap between resources and expenditures over the next two years is \$7.4m Key Dates (see attachment #1)
