CCSSE	Judy Redder shared a powerpoint presentation (attachment #1) on the 2008 Community College Survey of Student Engagement (CCSSE) Institutional Report. This is a summary of findings and detail findings in regard to students' college experiences and their engagement in the learning process. If you have questions, please contact Judy Redder at ext. 2313.  • The Oregon Community College Consortium worked together to conduct research using a common tool.  • CCSSE was administered for the first time in Winter 2008  • There were 38 multi-layered questions  • 48 states were involved with 343,378 participants  • 73% of Clackamas Community College (CCC) classes participated.  • In the future we can increase this number with more warning that the survey is coming.  • CC staff believe things will go smoother next time after going through this process once.  • Our Hispanic population is 6% (3% were surveyed). We under surveyed this group and our goal is to do better next time.  • Areas where CCC students rated CCC below other colleges were Student Effort, Academic Challenge, Student-Faculty Interaction, and Support for Learner.  • We need to think about how to use this information.  • Diane Drebin outlined several different data sources currently available and announced three 2 hour workshops to be presented and introduce staff to many different reports available to all (attachment #2)  Next Steps:  • Use these survey results for planning and improvement. Staff at the instructional level needs to look at this data to determine what the implications are for some of our instructional efforts.  • Mid-year and end of year reports to the Board should include this type of data.  • Review instructional roles, student needs, where to place our efforts and how to best support those efforts. This can be a catalyst for many discussions and refocu
