Accreditation Standard

Core Themes were reviewed (handout #1)

- Core themes are more proactive than a value; they are the essential aspects of our mission; as we identify core themes the discussion is a perfect parallel to the review of our mission and values; we need to be clear with our mission and objectives for accreditation
- Core theme examples from other community college were reviewed

Key Elements of the New Accreditation Standards (1-5) were reviewed:

- Examines the institution's interpretation and translation of its mission into practice
- Provides for continuous evaluation of the extent to which it achieves that mission
- Focuses on analysis and synthesis and a holistic view of the institution
- Integrates planning, action and assessment in shorter reporting intervals

The new accreditation cycle is seven years. As we transition into it, some colleges have a shorter cycle. We are on a five-year accreditation schedule this first time. Our next full accreditation visit is scheduled for 2015 and our year one report is due in Fall 2011.

Clackamas Community College's mission statement:

To serve the people of the college district with quality education and training opportunities that are accessible to all students, adaptable to changing needs, and accountable to the community we serve.

Expanded Presidents' Council members divided into two groups to discuss identify potential Clackamas Community College Core Themes. Their goal was to determine some of the essential elements of our mission. Elizabeth Lundy collected the suggested core themes.

Other comments and questions to be answered in the near future:

- Do our core themes reflect the essential elements of our mission?
- Do our core themes collectively encompass our mission?
- What does it mean for CCC to fulfill its mission?
