## Road Map: Planning and Budgeting

Joanne Truesdell shared information and led a discussion on budget planning and budget review continuing through July:

- Clackamas Community College (CCC) may experience a decrease of \$1.3 to \$1.6 million in 2010-11.
- We will go back and review budget lists; implemented plans/processes; revenue generation processes; residual ideas requiring board approval; and CCC members of the Board of Education goals.
- In February 2010 the CCC Board of Education asked that the college research differentiated tuition.
- Staff have until June 18 to get final registration materials processed.

#### In-Service

Jan Godfrey and Shelly Parini gave an update on in-service activities coming up in September 2010:

- The In-Service Task Force leaders, Kate Gray and Steve Beining plus other members of this energetic team have already pulled together a general outline of activities.
- The in-service theme is "Building Learning Centered Futures".
- As a prelude to in-service week we will be having nuts and bolts trainings for classified and faculty staff one week
  prior to in-service week.
- The week of in-service: Morning hours will be reserved for training opportunities specific to faculty (yet open to all); Wednesday we will have the traditional breakfast with guest speaker, Terry Doyle; afternoons there will be opportunities for professional enrichment classes; health and wellness activities will take place during the lunch hour; and we will end the week, Friday, with a barbecue hosted by our Associated Student Government on Friday.

- Scholarship recipient recognition event was moved from the month of May to September 21<sup>st</sup> (Tuesday evening of in-service week).

#### Yellow Robbon (Veterans) Career and Benefit Fair

Bill Zuelke shared information about the upcoming 2010 Yellow Ribbon Career and Benefits Fair beginning at 8:30 a.m. on June 26<sup>th</sup>:

- There will be special presentations by Senator Ron Wyden, Congressman David Wu, State Senator Martha Schrader and Clackamas County Commission Jim Bernard.
- 1,200 members of the Oregon National Guard, approximately 1,400 family members including 500 children, and approximately 1,000 veterans from all services and wars with a grand total of 3,600 veterans and family members expected on campus.
- While on campus they will have the option to attend a career fair where we will have 100+ employers with current job openings.

- Participants will include: 100 benefit providers and training institutions; 22 colleges and universities; Outlaw
  Barbecue will be providing food; 50 volunteers from Clackamas Community College; 50 soldiers will help to direct
  traffic; the "Y" will assist with 150 children ages 0-5 years of age; Home Depot is providing 400 bird house kits and
  staff to assist children with making them; Jim Martineau has organized a team to have a field day out on the
  softball field; and David Andersen of the Art Department is coordinating art instructors and students to assist
  children with painting projects.
- Veterans will be taking classes throughout the day; 6 different hour long seminars; all 1,200 guard members will be taking at least 3 hours of training.
- The fair Closes at 3:00 pm
- National press: CBS Evening News will cover the event.
- CCC will have a great opportunity for outreach to many new potential students.
- CCC staff are being asked to wear name tags and CCC identifiable shirts if not wearing a yellow volunteer shirt.
