# **Governor's Budget**

Courtney Wilton invited Presidents' Council members to his office at 4:00 p.m. to listen to a Legislative conference call. Legislative call agenda:

Courtney shared a Financial Forecast Update [Handout #1] for the Clackamas Community College (CCC) Fiscal Year 2010-11.

- Recap of General Fund Revenue.
- Recap of General Fund Expenses:
  - o 81% of CCC's budget is salaries and benefits.
  - Benefit cost will increase significantly due to PERS rate increase of 6.5 percentage points.
- Next Year's Key Budget Issues: Revenue and Expenses:
  - o Governor's budget: Funding is down 9%.
  - Reduced from current biennium budget of \$450m to \$410m.
  - Per student drop is approximately 10.6%.
- Recap of Forecasted Deficits:
  - o At \$410m State Support:
    - 11/12: \$3.6m ■ 12/13: \$4.9m
    - Total: \$8.5m
- Budget Strategies:
  - o Cushion with available reserves.
  - o Increase revenue.
  - Look for efficiencies / decrease spending.
- Budget Strategy Examples.
- Risks: State Funding, Enrollment, Grant Revenues, and Expenses.
- Key Dates External
- Key Dates Internal
  - o January-February 4: Idea generation.
  - February 7-18: Analysis and refinement.
  - February 21-March 11: Creation of proposed budget.
  - April 13 and May 11: Board of Education and Budget Committee meetings / budget approval (May).
  - o May 2011: Bond election.
  - o June 2011: CCC 2011-12 Budget adopted and finalized.
