#### **ACCREDITATION STEERING COMMITTEE (ASC)**

Bill Waters reported on behalf of the Accreditation Steering Committee about recommendations on the Clackamas Community College Mission Statement.

- Bill reported to Presidents' Council (PC) on January 10, 2012 regarding the Year One Peer Evaluation Report. PC's charge to the Accreditation Steering Committee was to clarify our mission statement and present an updated Mission Statement and recommendation to Expanded Presidents' Council (EPC) on January 24, 2012.
- Eligibility Requirement 3: Mission and Core Themes (Analysis by Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities)
  - Clackamas Community College (CCC) needs to ensure consistent wording of its' mission in all places published.
  - The mission statement is being clarified so the specific mission of the College may be generally understood.
  - The mission statement used in the Year One Peer Evaluation Report will be used consistently to reflect current terms and accreditation language.
  - Mission Statement: "To serve the people of the college district with quality education and training opportunities that are accessible to all students, adaptable to changing needs, and accountable to the community we serve."
- Handout #3: Bill distributed a copy of the Accreditation Steering Committee Recommendations; a sample of
  what visitors currently see when they click on "About Us" on our website at
  <a href="http://www.clackamas.edu/inside.asp?content=0200-07">http://www.clackamas.edu/inside.asp?content=0200-07</a>; and the current and revised draft of the "Who we are"
  page from the Visions to Reality document. How and where the mission statement and core themes should
  appear was discussed.
- The Banyan Tree poster with mission statement was also discussed as it needs updating and needs to be consistent with the other 3 documents mentioned in handout #3.
- It was suggested to include our core themes (4 bulleted items) wherever the mission statement appears; however, core themes must remain separate from the mission statement.
  - o It was suggested that a paragraph/descriptor of each core theme be included and placed under the philosophy heading.

# Next Steps & Decisions:

- Updating of our mission statement is approved. We need to make it easier to read and understand.
- Update the mission statement on all documents, website and poster for consistency.
- Incorporate bulleted core themes but not under the Mission Statement heading.
- Visions to Reality document and poster: Work with our Public Affairs staff to locate and place the bulleted core themes according to marketing perspective.
- "About us" website: The bulleted core themes should appear just as broadly as our mission statement; however, they cannot be part of the mission statement. Stay consistent with Visions to Reality document and Banyan poster.
- Bill Waters will present samples of updated (with suggested changes from today) Visions to Reality document "Who we are" page, Banyan Tree poster and website:
