


Student Conduct

The Board expects student conduct to contribute to a productive learning climate. Students shall comply with the College's written rules of student conduct, submit to the lawful authority of College staff and conduct themselves in an orderly manner at all times on campus and while in attendance at College-sponsored programs and activities.

A student code of conduct, developed under the leadership of the College administration and in cooperation with staff, will be made available to students and enforced. Students in violation of Board policy, administrative regulation and/or code of conduct provisions will be subject to discipline up to and including expulsion. Additionally, students may be denied participation in extracurricular activities. Titles and/or privileges granted to students may be revoked (e.g., academic honors, student body, class or club office positions, etc.). A referral to law enforcement may also be made.

Students are prohibited from making knowingly false statements or knowingly submitting false information in bad faith as part of a complaint or report, or associated with an investigation into misconduct.¹



¹ The College is prohibited from retaliating against any student "for the reason that the student has in good faith reported information that the student believes is evidence of a violation of a state or federal law, rule or regulation." ORS 659.852.
