Decision Making

- Informal voting procedures will use Fist-to-Five voting
 - Any fist to 2: more discussion & information needed
 - Majority 4-5: moving to formal vote.
- Formal Voting:
 - Internal decisions do not require a formal vote
 - Decisions that impact others go to formal vote
 - Minimum Votes Required: (3/4ths of current membership)
 - Threshold for Passing: 66%
- Non-members cannot vote at any point.

 - Community members may participate throughout the meeting, unless otherwise noted in our meeting agenda.
 - Each meeting agenda will have at least 5 minutes scheduled specifically for community feedback and input.
 - Community members can always reach out with emailed questions at any time.
