Decision Making

- Informal Voting Procedures will use Fist to Five Voting.
- Informal Voting Guidelines:
 - Any fist to 2 = more discussion & information.
 - Majority vote of 3 = more discussion & information.
 - Majority vote of 4-5 = moving to formal vote.
- Formal Voting:
 - Internal decisions do not require a formal vote.
 - Decisions that impact others should be a formal vote.
 - o Formal vote occurs one meeting after an informal vote.
 - Minimum Votes Required: 12 (3/4ths of membership)
 - Threshold for Passing: 66% Vote Yes
- Non-members cannot vote at any point.
