SUBJECT: Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

PURPOSE: Recognizes participation in an organized continuing education

experience under responsible sponsorship, capable direction, and

qualified instruction.

REGULATION: One CEU is defined as ten contact hours of participation.

CONDITIONS:

- 1. CEUs reflect attendance only.
- 2. Course content and instructor credentials are approved by the appropriate college department.
- CEUs do not count toward college credit.
- 4. CEUs are non-credit.
- 5. A workshop outline must be on file in the Curriculum Office for approval.
- 6. The instructor is responsible for teaching and submitting verification of attendance to the Registration & Records Office within the term the workshop takes place.
- 7. Departments wishing to issue a CEU Certificate of Attendance may do so.
- 8. A separate CEU transcript is maintained by the Registration & Records Office.
- 9. The college is an approved provider to offer IACET (International Association for Continuing Education & Training) CEUs. A department wishing to offer IACET CEUs will work with the Customized Training Department to be sure IACET requirements are met before the workshop can be offered.

CONDITIONS:

- Earned CEUs reflect attendance only.
- Course content and instructor credentials are approved by the appropriate college department.
- 7. CEUs do not count toward college credit.
- 8. CEUs are non-credit, and carry the course number 009. The uniqueness of the course is represented in the title.
- CEUs may be FTE reimbursable if in accordance with state guidelines.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Creation of CEUs is the same as for credit classes using the Grand and Term Master process.
- 2. A course outline must be on file in the appropriate division office.
- The instructor is responsible for the course outline, teaching, verification of attendance and grade submission to the Registrar within the term grading cycle.
- 4. Grade options are "CEU" "W" or "UG" (unreported.)
- Departments wishing to issue a CEU certificate of attendance are welcome to do so.
- 6. A separate CEU transcript is maintained by the Registrar's Office.
