

**SUBJECT:** Multiple Degrees/Certificates of Completion

**PURPOSE:** Establishes regulation and conditions for awarding multiple associate degrees and/or certificates of completion.

**REGULATION:** A student may earn multiple or subsequent associate degrees and/or certificates of completion. ~~according to the conditions stated below.~~

**CONDITIONS:**

1. Multiple degrees/certificates may be earned as follows:
  - a. One AAOT
  - b. One AGS
  - c. One or more AS each with differing program areas or tracks
  - d. ~~One ASOT-Business~~
  - e. One or more AAS each with differing program areas
  - f. One or more certificates of completion each with differing program areas
  - g. One or more Career Pathway Certificates
  
2. Students must satisfy all the requirements for each degree or certificate.  
*(Note: For the procedure, please see Appendix M of the ISP Manual.)*
  
- ~~2. The student must earn a minimum of 24 additional credits for associate degrees, and an additional 12 credits for certificates of completion for each subsequent degree or certificate awarded.
  - a. All additional coursework must be college level.
  - b. Additional coursework may be accepted from other accredited institutions.~~
  
3. The student must request file a separate Petition for Graduation with the Registrar's Office for each award earned. ~~associate degree and/or certificate of completion.~~
