

**SUBJECT: Recognition of Academic Excellence (Honor Roll and President's List)**

**PURPOSE:** Establishes regulation and conditions for recognizing students who achieve a measure of academic excellence.

**REGULATION:** Students will be recognized for their academic excellence each term and at the College's commencement ceremony.

**CONDITIONS:**

1. The Enrollment Services Office will post to the student's transcript an Honor Roll or President's List notation for each term a student has met all the following conditions:  
For term recognition:
  - a. Earn a term GPA of 3.5-3.749 to be recognized as part of the Honor Roll.
  - b. Earn a term GPA of 3.75 or greater to be recognized as part of the President's List.
  - c. For both levels, students must complete a minimum of 6 credits with grades of A, B, C, or D. (A grade of P is allowed as long as there are a minimum of 6 credits of A, B, C, or D.)
2. Honor and President's List students will be recognized at graduation.

- ~~1. Students who earn a 3.5 or greater term GPA will be recognized at the end of each term for academic excellence on their academic transcripts.
  - ~~a. Students must complete a minimum of 9 credits and all 9 credits must reflect grades of A, B, C, or D~~
  - ~~b. No failing courses for the term are allowed.~~~~
- ~~2. Students who petition for graduation and earn a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or greater by the end of the winter term preceding commencement will be recognized for their academic excellence in the commencement program.~~

**PROCEDURES:**

- ~~1. The Registrar's Office will post to the student's transcript an Honor Roll notation (for each term a student has met all of condition #1.)~~
- ~~2. The Registrar's Office will forward to the college Publications Office a list of those students to be noted in the commencement program for academic excellence as indicated in condition #2.~~
