SUBJECT: Adult Basic Education (ABE)

General Educational Development (GED)

PURPOSE: Provides open entry/open exit basic skills instruction and offers

the opportunity for students to earn a GED (General Education

Development) certificate of high school equivalency.

REGULATION: Students must be at least sixteen (16) years old; those under

eighteen (18) are admitted only with a letter of release from compulsory attendance or a referral from contracting school or

agency.

CONDITIONS:

1. Entry assessment test scores determine ABE or GED level placement.

- Students failing to demonstrate an ability to benefit may be referred to Counseling for special advising.
- Practice GED tests are given in the Dye Learning Center during designated times. Appointments are recommended and made through the Skills Development department.
- Final GED tests are given in the CCC Testing Center. Testing Center
