New ITS Service Desk - Dave Gates & Shawn Swanner

Communications/emails were sent out introducing the new ITS Service Desk.

They gave the group a quick demo of how it works. The main page shows 3 major icons (request links):

- 1. ITS Trouble Ticket (something is broken).
- 2. IT Service Request (new things or things that aren't broken).
- 3. Web Service Request (nothing broken need help with the website).

Top Knowledge Articles are at the top of the home page and now are showing how to create a service request ticket. Different topics/articles will cycle through. Eventually there will be an FAQ's page.

For the request, you must choose a category. If a category is not there, let ITS know. There is also the ability to add attachments. Hit green button at bottom to save.

You can now see what is happening with your ticket(s). Action Log is for the requestor and the person working on the ticket. If you need to add comment, you can and then hit save.

This will be evolving as it goes on. Bill is the dot net developer. The system does not send you an email if a comment is added by ITS. It is a feature that is there but not turned on yet.

Staff can still call x3500 during business hours. The tech will be entering a ticket while they are talking to you. Right now Will monitors the tickets - he looks and evaluates the ticket.

There is a concern voiced about the new Outlook that was upgraded during the winter break. Could there have been training before people left for break? If an upgrade that will change things over a break, maybe the email could state in BOLD that your email is going to look different over break?

ITS does upgrades during breaks because they can't take down major systems during the term. Sometimes the upgrades seem intuitive to IT but may not be for everyone else. Maybe a small focus group to look at upgrades?

<u>CCEA (Culture, Communications and Engagement Assessment) Metrics for College Council – BJ</u> <u>Nicoletti & Jenelle Vader</u>

Jenelle serves on the College Council Recharge (CCR) Task Force. The CCR makes recommendations to Presidents' Council.

Last year the CCR looked at the nuts & bolts of committees on campus. Updates were made to committee websites. CCR asked each committee to report out to College Council last year.

The College took the CCEA two years ago. This was an all staff and faculty survey. For metrics to track at the College Council meetings, 4 questions from the CCEA were chosen. Things that are meaningful for us to track. Possibly tying into core themes.

- 1. Employee suggestions are sought out and used to improve the experience of students.
- 2. Executive leadership (President and VPs) communicates well with the rest of the organization.
- 3. There are processes in place for me to be involved in planning and decision-making within my service area/department.
- 4. There is a spirit of teamwork and cooperation at this institution.

Why did these 4 get chosen? Nora who is also on the CCR said that CCR is envisioning what College Council is/does. College Council is like a town crier place. A place to report out so information is brought to the campus. Teamwork and cooperation is important at College Council. Employee comments are heard.

#3 Is specific to a service area/department instead of campus wide. Functionality of CC is to help people feel engaged in planning at the college level. CC is not a decision making body. It should go back to the area it came from. Group is recommending these four questions. If these questions feel correct – how do we track over time? Who is the team that would watch over these?

BJ & Jenelle will swing back at the next College Council to check-in when they should do the next survey. Do we like it the way it is or should we do a different one?
