ISP 471

Courses repeatable for additional credit

PURPOSE

Defines the conditions which allow a student to repeat a course for additional credit towards degree completion.

SUMMARY

Students may repeat a course as often as they wish. However, only in certain circumstances may credits from a repeated course be applied towards degree completion.

STANDARD

- 1. Certain classes may be repeated for additional credit towards degree completion as specified in the catalog.
- 2. When repeated for additional credit, such courses are non-challengeable.
- 3. Variable credit courses may be repeated and credits applied to degree completion only up to the number of credits allowed for the class.
- 4. CWE courses may be repeated and credits applied. Specific procedures, limitations, and conditions are specified in ISP 390 in this manual.
