Pre-college Pipeline Charge

The pre-college pipeline workgroup is charged with guiding a team of key stakeholders to ensure that pre-college programs, most notably developmental education (e.g., ABE/GED/ESL) and High School Connections programs are considered as on ramps to guided pathways and are implemented as such. In collaboration with the Curriculum workgroup, we will develop streamlined paths for precollege students to reduce time to completion and clear pathways for High School Connections students to meet degree and/or certificate goals.
