<b>CCC’s Digital Signage Network / Jack Hardy</b>	The project to upgrade CCC’s digital signage network at the Oregon City, Harmony and Wilsonville campuses began a year ago. The College Relations and Marketing manages content, updates, and connects through this channel of communication with our campus visitors, existing students, faculty and staff.
