The Council's Guiding Principles include: Consensus: When making decisions and recommendations, we seek broad agreement on specific issues and the overall direction of the college in service to its mission. Transparency: When we make decisions or recommendations, we have a common understanding and ability to articulate and explain what decisions have been made, and the decision process. Answerability: As the stewards of communication, we have a shared responsibility for explanation, discussion, and implementation of decisions and recommendations among constituent groups and across the college. Engagement: We encourage engagement across the college.
