

- One application for 5 different student employment & leadership opportunities across campus



Universal Application




Students fill out main application information one time for all positions for which they want to apply.




Aligned with Educational Focus Areas (EFAs)








Language and layout between CCC webpages and application are mirrored throughout the application to provide consistency and clarity






Multiple Compensation Options in One Place
